



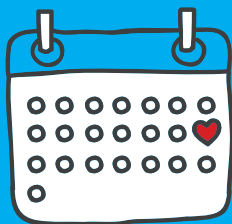

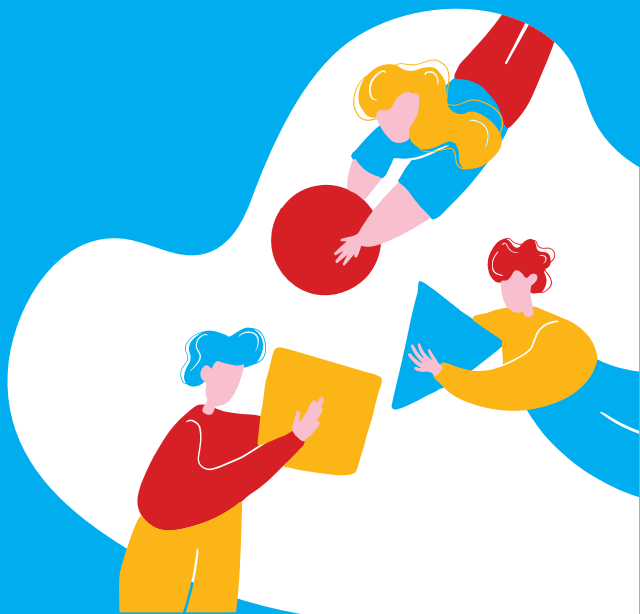

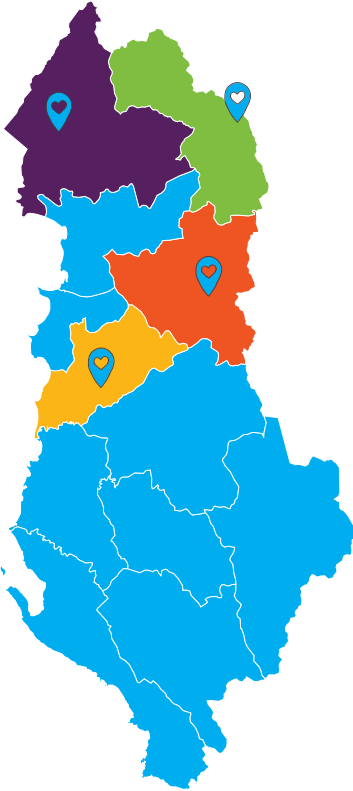

OVERALL OBJECTIVE OF THE INTERVENTION

The intervention aims to contribute towards the prevention and an overall reduction in the prevalence of human trafficking in and from Albania.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

OUTCOME 1

Innovative and strategic communications bring positive changes in knowledge and attitudes of targeted population to human trafficking and reduce their vulnerability.



OUTCOME 2

Strengthened effectiveness in investigation, prosecution and implementation of the amended Criminal Procedure Code at the regional level to enhance the rights of victims of trafficking.



OUTCOME 3

Victims and potential victims of trafficking are timely identified, their immediate needs are addressed, and their reintegration is facilitated.



OUTCOME 4

Preventive resilience building and reintegration of victims of trafficking and potential victims of trafficking through education, vocational training and alternative employment support.

RESEARCH AND STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION



Research

What do people know about human trafficking and what is their attitude to it?



Awareness raising

Increasing knowledge and changing attitudes on the phenomena.

OUTCOME 2

LAW ENFORCEMENT AND JUSTICE



Effective and efficient response to human trafficking

Intersectoral collaboration between key agencies and stakeholders to detect, investigate and prosecute human trafficking related crimes.



Increased capacities of law enforcement and criminal justice professionals

Capacities of justice and law enforcement agencies strengthened on human trafficking.

OUTCOME 3

SERVICES FOR POTENTIAL VICTIMS (PVs) / VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING (VoTs) WITH FOCUS ON REINTEGRATION



Early identification and support to (potential) victims and victims of trafficking

Services are readily available and tailored to people affected by human trafficking.



Emergency assistance

Emergency response teams are deployed and provide immediate support to (potential) victims of human trafficking 24/7.



Mental health and counselling

Psychosocial support and mental health counselling.

OUTCOME 4

REINTEGRATION OF POTENTIAL VICTIMS (PVs)/VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING (VoTs)



Early intervention and risk reduction for trafficking and abuse

Working with communities to prevent risk to trafficking and abuse.



Employment opportunities and engagement with labor market

Providing economic and employment opportunities to people at risk or already affected by trafficking and abuse.

- 50 Potential Victims (PVs) / Victims of Trafficking (VoTs) receive immediate full emergency support;
- 150 Potential Victims (PVs) / Victims of Trafficking (VoTs) receive tailored support towards independent life;
- 225 (125 females) Potential Victims (PVs) / Victims of Trafficking (VoTs) supported through economic re-integration programme;
- 250 youth at risk empowered with life and employment skills;
- 250 at risk families receive tailored professional support;
- 265 justice system professionals provided with skills development;
- 200 local stakeholders provided with skills improvement support;
- 2,000 adolescents engaged in human trafficking campaign;
- 3,000 adolescents and youth at risk supported through online psychological counselling;
- Outreach work.
